### ABOUT THE EXPERIENCE

Join the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism (USCJ) as we head to Israel for a memorable journey in the Land of Milk & Honey. Together we will experience the magic of Jerusalem, the thrill of the Dead Sea, and the beauty of the Galilee. The program includes visits to Israel's must-sees along with wonderful cultural experiences, an authentic Shabbat experience in Jerusalem, insightful speakers, and meals at some of the best restaurants in Israel.

HAZAK is the USCJ organization for mature Jewish adults. It provides programming for people, age 55 and older, who are members of our affiliated congregations. The HAZAK Journey to Israel program is appropriate for active adults. You are not required to be a member of HAZAK or a United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism synagogue to participate in this trip.

### PROGRAM ITINERARY

*The following are highlights of the HAZAK Journey to Israel. A confirmed itinerary will be distributed approximately two months prior to the program and is subject to change.*

#### **SUNDAY, DAY 1 / Depart for Israel**

Meet fellow travelers for group flight from New York, or arrange your own flight to Israel. Check-in for our direct group flight to Tel Aviv and spend the night in the sky en route to Israel.

#### **MONDAY, DAY 2 / Dreaming of Modern Israel**

Arrive to Israel in the morning, meet our local Israeli guide, and start the ascent to Jerusalem. After a shecheyanu prayer at the Haas Promenade overlooking the Old City, we start our journey at the Theodore Herzl Museum on Mt. Herzl where Israel's founders and heads of state are buried. Here we trace the history of Zionist thought from its inception to the present. From Mt. Herzl we make our way to the picturesque Jerusalem village of Ein Karem for lunch and to view the Chagall Windows at Hadassah Hospital. We check-in to our hotel in the afternoon to relax before formal program introductions and a delicious restaurant dinner. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Dinner]

#### **TUESDAY, DAY 3 / Cosmopolitan Israel**

Transfer to Tel Aviv in the morning where we recount the struggle for a Jewish State at the Palmach Museum followed by a visit to Independence Hall where we relive the founding of modern Israel. Celebrate the vibrancy of Tel Aviv by strolling down the street festival along Nahalat Binyamin. Continue on through Tel Aviv's historic "White City" district – which was recently recognized as a UNESCO world-heritage site for its unique Bauhaus architecture. Our visit to Tel Aviv concludes on a somber note at Rabin Square Memorial, the site of Yitzhak Rabin's assassination. Return to Jerusalem in the early evening to close out the day at a Jerusalem restaurant. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Dinner]

### **WEDNESDAY, DAY 4 / The Old City of Jerusalem**

Today we step back in time to the foundations of Jerusalem at the “City of David” archeological complex, dating back to the era of King David and Kings Solomon. Next we enter the Jewish Quarter of the Old City via the historic Zion Gate. Explore the alleyways, rooftops and tunnels of the Jewish Quarter – culminating with a moment of reflection at the Kotel – the Western Wall. In the afternoon, participants will be able to choose between exploring the Kotel Tunnels or the Davidson Center/Southern Wall Excavations. We conclude our tour of the Old City altogether at the Chain of Generations exhibit. Dinner tonight is a traditional and gourmet Moroccan restaurant in Jerusalem. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Dinner]

### **THURSDAY, DAY 5 / The Judean Desert**

Wake up early and begin the journey to the lowest place on earth – the Judean Desert. Ascend Masada via the cable cars and tour Herod’s famous mountaintop fortress and palace. Descend from Masada and travel to the Dead Sea. Here we will take time to float on the salty waters and relax in the natural thermal hotsprings at Ein Gedi Spa. Wrap-up the day with a traditional desert tent feast at Eretz Breisheit. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Dinner]

### **FRIDAY, DAY 6 / Loss & Redemption**

Begin the day with an emotional visit to the Yad VaShem Holocaust Memorial. The rest of the day is free time for taking a stroll in Jerusalem or relaxing at a local park. Or enjoy shopping in Mahane Yehuda open air marketplace for those who wish to experience the energy of pre-Shabbat shopping in Jerusalem. As the sun begins to set we reconvene as a group to prepare for Shabbat – the day of rest. Kabbalat Shabbat services will be held at a local Jerusalem synagogue followed by a festive Shabbat dinner at the hotel. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Dinner]

### **SATURDAY, DAY 7 / Shabbat in Jerusalem**

Join in Shabbat services at the Fuchsberg Jerusalem Center for Conservative Judaism in followed by lunch at the Fuchsberg Jerusalem Center. In the afternoon we take a walking tour of Jerusalem’s colorful neighborhoods. After marking Shabbat’s end with the Havdallah service, the evening is free to explore Jerusalem on your own. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: (Breakfast / Lunch)]

### **SUNDAY, DAY 8 / Modern Jerusalem**

Today is our final day in Jerusalem, and we start it with a visit to a local Masorti (Conservative) school followed by a panel discussion of Masorti rabbis and a tour of the Fuchsberg Jerusalem Center. From there, we visit the acclaimed Menachen Begin Heritage Museum followed by a group tree planting ceremony in a nearby park. Lunch today is along Jerusalem’s lively Emek Refa’im district. The rest of the afternoon is free time for shopping and personal exploration in Jerusalem. Overnight: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Lunch]

### **MONDAY, DAY 9 / Along the Mediterranean Coast**

We begin our travels northward along the Mediterranean Coast with a stop at the Caesarea amphitheater on the beach. From Caesarea we head high into the Carmel Mountains and enjoy a traditional lunch and hospitality in a local Druze village. After lunch we stop for a walking tour of Zichron Yaacov – one of the first towns established as part of the Zionist Movement of the 19th century – followed by a tasting at a local winery. View sunset over Haifa from the Bahai Temple Gardens before heading east for our hotel on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight: Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner]

### **TUESDAY, DAY 10 / Mystics of the Galilee**

Wake up along the shoreline of the Sea of Galilee as we begin our day by ascending to Tsfat – the birthplace of the Kabbalah – high in the hills of the Galilee. Here we explore the ancient alleyways of this picturesque town and learn about the unique development of Jewish thought that has transpired here through the course of Jewish history. From Tsfat we head to Misgav Am, a highpoint with an overlook across Israel to Lebanon her neighbors. As we head downhill, we stop for a walking tour of the Hula Valley Nature Reserve – a world famous site for observing migratory birds. We close out the day with a sunset cruise on the Sea of Galilee followed by dinner at Decks Restaurant along the shoreline of Tiberias. Overnight: Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar Guest House [Meals Provided: Breakfast / Dinner]

### **WEDNESDAY, DAY 11 / The Golan Heights**

This is our final day in Israel, and before checking out of the hotel we take a moment for a wrap-up session and an opportunity to discuss what the experiences of the program have meant. Before traveling back towards the airport, we ascend the Golan Heights for a visit to the Gamla complex – commonly referred to as “the Masada of the Galilee”. From the Golan we head south along the Jordan Valley to tour Beit Shean’s extensive Roman-era archeological complex followed by a visit to Old Geshur Museum – a site central in Israel’s 1948 War of Independence. We conclude the program with a return to Tel Aviv and a walking tour of old Jaffa seaport at twilight followed by a banquet dinner at Tzel Hayam Restaurant along the beach. Following dinner we return to Ben Gurion Airport to say our goodbyes prior to boarding the overnight group flight back to North America.

### **THURSDAY, DAY 12 / SHALOM!**

Our group flight arrives back to the New York area in the early morning after ten days in Israel full of new experiences, new insights, and new friendships.

### **EILAT EXTENSION PACKAGE + OPTIONAL PETRA DAY TOUR**

Cap off your journey in Israel with a 3-night/3-day extension to Eilat – Israel’s Red Sea resort town. Before heading back to the United States, relax at the Dan Panorama resort hotel on the water. Enjoy Eilat’s warm climate, beautiful views, and unique tropical ocean attractions. Package includes round trip domestic flights to/from Eilat, accommodations at the Dan Panorama Hotel in Eilat, breakfast daily and all Shabbat meals. An optional privately guided day tour of Petra in Jordan is available.
