Workshops on leadership and essential skills, community service, text study and a phenomenal Shabbat will round out the program. There will be time to meet in small groups and network with students from across the continent.

Accommodations will be provided at the Holiday Inn in Brookline, a short walk from campus. There will be three to four people in each room and meals are included. Thanks to a generous gift from Women's League for Conservative Judaism, the cost for the Kallah (not including transportation) is **only \$100**.

Register no later than February 10th, 2012. Space cannot be guaranteed after that time. Upon receipt of your application and deposit, additional details will be sent to you. Should you need to cancel your Kallah reservation, please note that refunds will only be available until February 17.

Plan to arrive in Boston by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 23rd. Bus transportation (for a nominal fee) will be available from BU to Logan Airport on the return. The Kallah will conclude at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, February 26th.
