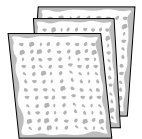

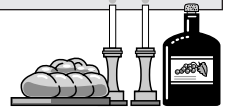

#### From I-287 North or South

Exit 35 (old Exit 31) onto Madison Ave./Old Route 24 West toward the Morristown business district;  
Go about 0.5 mile to the Morristown Green;  
Turn right at the Green onto South Park Place;  
Go one block, follow the Green around to the left onto East Park Place, keeping to extreme right-hand lane;  
Exit the Green after these two short blocks (two sides of the square) onto Speedwell Ave.;  
Go about 1/4 mile, turn right immediately after fire house into synagogue parking lot.

#### From Garden State Parkway

Exit 142 to I-78 West, to Route 24 West, to I-287 South; or Exit 145 to I-280 West, to I-287 South; or Exit 159 to I-80 West, to I-287 South;  
Continue as above.

 Turn right, continue through four short STOP signs to Anderson Ave.;

All lead into Route 95, keep in local lanes, exit at last exit in NJ, marked Fort Lee-Palisades Pkwy, bear right on ramp;

 Go 500 feet to first street on right, make right on Anderson Ave., continue for 1/2 mile;
