Why is this so important? Beyond the symbolic importance in having as large a Conservative delegation as possible, this election determines 50% of the control of the Jewish Agency which disperses over \$300 million in funds to many organizations including USY, Ramah and Masorti.

What is the process? Starting in September, all American Jews over 18 will be eligible to register through synagogues and Jewish organizations. There is a \$4 fee which goes towards offsetting the cost of the election. Registration ends on December 15, 2001 followed by balloting.

### How to Register

Please read and complete the form. Sign your name where indicated. Every item in the required section must be completed in full and legibly printed.

- Registrant's signature on the form confirms all four of the following statements:
  - I accept the Jerusalem Program.
  - I am Jewish.
  - I was born on or before June 30, 1983.
  - I reside on a full-time, permanent basis in the U.S..
- Each individual must complete his/her own form, which may be photocopied, but an individual may register only once. Duplicates will be invalidated. Each registration must be mailed in its own envelope and postmarked no later than December 14, 2001.
- Enclose a \$4.00 payment. Payment can be made with registrant's personal check for \$4.00, payable to the American Zionist Movement, or by credit card. (The credit card must be in the name of the registrant and must be a personal, not corporate or institutional, credit card.) Neither cash nor money orders will be accepted. No ballot will be sent if the registration fee is not paid. Should the election be deferred or cancelled, refunds cannot be made. You may also register on-line. Go to [www.azm.org](http://www.azm.org) to find the link to the secured registration site. You may only use a credit card for on-line registration.
