Project Reconnect's mission is to re-involve, re-invigorate, and reconnect the very many Jewish adults who were touched by the Conservative movement's programs for teenagers, college students and young adults, including USY, ATID, KOACH, NATIV, the Conservative Yeshiva, Camp Ramah, the Solomon Schechter day schools, and the Leadership Training Fellowship. Its Israel component provides a rich resource for potential olim and also for strengthening Israel - Diaspora relationships.

We consider every person who participated in some aspect of Conservative movement programming in his or her formative years to be a precious resource. We welcome all alumni, regardless of current affiliation.

We invite you to partner with Project Reconnect in reaching out to the many alumni with whom we have lost touch, and to reconnect them to an increasingly vibrant Jewish community, by making a contribution either to the **Project Reconnect General Fund** (which enables us to use your funds where most needed at the time) or to any special fund that suits your interest.

**Nina and Rabbi Paul Freedman Israel Fund**

The Freedmans' fund supports Conservative Jews in making aliyah to Israel. Through outreach to graduates of Conservative youth and adult programs, this fund will assist them with their klitah (absorption) into Israeli society and help them to reconnect with our community. It also supports hayalim bodedim, the lonely soldiers who have left their families to follow their dream to live in Israel and who now serve to protect it.

**Jerry Gottesman z"l Technology Fund**

Established in loving memory of Jerry Gottesman, long-time United Synagogue board member, this fund is used to help maintain and enhance Project Reconnect's website and database, and to provide related technological services.

**Jackie Saltz Programming Fund**

Jackie's fund helps to underwrite human resources as well as materials and communications for alumni programs at regional and international gatherings, such as the reunion that was held at the last United Synagogue international biennial convention.

**Marjorie Saulson Public Relations Fund**

Marjorie's fund contributes toward the promotion of outreach programming such as Come Home for the Holidays, which arranges for free High Holiday tickets for alumni living away from home, and Kol Dichfin, which finds seders for alumni who otherwise would not be able to attend one.
